Cross Country speed 400 mpm
Entry Fee: £13
- Class 4 **OPEN INTERMEDIATE**
Fences not exceeding 1.15m.

ARENA TRAINING EVENT RULES

The competition will follow the format of an outdoor one-day event as closely as possible. Dress code will be as for show jumping.

The result will be decided on lowest penalties, then nearest to the optimum time in the event of equality.

JUMPING in ARENA:

All fences will knock down. In the first phase the fences will be coloured and include six to eight fences with up to two combinations. The second phase will have seven to ten rustic fences including one double, built to resemble cross-country fences. Each phase has a time allowed and time limit. After the first phase the competitor will go on to the second phase, even if they have faults in the first phase (but not if eliminated). They must wait for the bell to ring before starting either phase to allow accurate timing.

JUMPING PENALTIES:

Knock down = 4 penalties; 1st disobedience = 4; 2nd disobedience = 8; 3rd disobedience = elimination; first fall of competitor = 8; 2nd fall of competitor, first fall of horse, exceeding time limit, error of course, retaking an obstacle already jumped = elimination, when the competitor must leave the arena. Every second over time allowed = 1 penalty.

The winner will be the competitor with the lowest combined score.

ENTRIES: Horses may be entered in two classes. Completed entry forms should be sent with the correct entry fee to Mrs Jane Cepok, Gleneagles Equestrian Centre, Auchterarder, Perthshire PH3 1NZ by **FRIDAY 19 FEBRUARY 2010**. Early entry is advisable. Please make cheques payable to “**GLENEAGLES HOTEL**”. There will be no refunds after this date. Should the event have to be cancelled a £2.00 administrative fee will be retained.
