SHOOTING SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP

The Shooting School at Gleneagles was established in 1985 as the Jackie Stewart Shooting School. For the next 15 years it remained under his directorship, gradually evolving into the world class Sporting Clays layout that it is today. 1997 saw further expansion of the business to include the Fishing School at which fly fishing techniques are taught. At this time the Archery facility and the Air-rifle range were substantially developed giving the Shooting and Fishing Schools a broad range of activities to entertain guests and members. In December 2001 Gleneagles took over sole control of the facility and subsequently it has developed further with substantial investments in the schools.

Situated to the north of the resort, the Shooting Lodge and ground is located on a beautiful moorland with magnificent panoramic views out over Glendalmond Hills towards the highlands. Run as a small nature preserve it is common to see most of Scotland’s wildlife species coexisting happily with the shooting. This is very much the case with fly fishing also, where, on our stocked trout lochs, it is common to see Ospreys helping themselves to the trout too.

Serving Gleneagles they are certainly among the world’s most popular and busy Shooting and Fishing Schools, where all ages from eight years upward are taught to shoot and fish. Apart from their commitment to the resort guests, the schools have a substantial and keen membership, who are always looked after by a dedicated instructor, who tailors the presentation of the targets to suit any skill requirement. Membership includes Fishing, Archery and Air-rifle outings, again with dedicated instructors to look after you and your guests.

The Sporting Clays layout has fifteen major stands including the demanding and variable compact complex. Amongst the many and testing stands, there are three high towers that present targets to challenge even the most accomplished shooters. The facility also has the benefit of purpose built covered Archery and Air-rifle ranges, where a shelter allows shooting to continue in poor weather.

FISHING SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP

Fly-fishing has proved a very popular activity at Gleneagles over recent years with considerable interest and demand amongst our guests and members for learning this iconic form of fishing. We are now pleased to be able to offer a fishing membership. This year we have taken the fishing at the Cromlix estate where three scenic, secluded yet convenient lochs are exclusive to Gleneagles.

Individual Membership:

EQUESTRIAN SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP

Her Royal Highness, the Princess Royal opened the School in June 1988. It was designed by Captain Mark Phillips to be a Centre of Excellence. The impressive Gleneagles arena is second to none with its pine wood lined modern judges’ box, PA system and enormous work area of 75m x 37m. Seating is provided for 700 spectators. Overlooking all three arenas is the bar and restaurant facility, which is open for events, offering a comfortable atmosphere.

The Grampian Arena, which is 20m x 40m is well equipped with mirrors to help riders study their positions and aid them with the schooling of their horses. An outdoor arena, the Strathallan, is situated just outside the Grampian Arena. It measures 60m x 40m and is an ideal venue for dressage and jumping competitions.

Beyond the two large horse box parks are situated the cross-country courses, intro (*0.9m), pre-novice (1.00m) and novice (1.10m). There is a training course of smaller fences, (up to 0.85m), built to enable less experienced horses and riders to learn cross-country skills. Regular cross-country training clinics are available and a very successful British Eventing One Day Event and Hunter Trials are held.

The school runs two stable yards, providing accommodation for up to 50 horses and ponies. It is not only a busy riding school and livery yard, but also a British Horse Society training and examination centre. Specialist career training courses can be arranged from BHS Stage 1 to BHSI level. The course content and duration is dependent on the individual’s requirements and budget.

Carriage driving, side-saddle, equestrian vaulting, dressage, show jumping and cross-country are all offered at the school.
